



Total ITBs Awarded or Pending Award By District (as of April 15, 2017)







- 51 projects awarded for FY 2017










Glynn County/City of Brunswick extend two existing left turn lanes on SR 25 Spur @ Scranton Road

LMIG Off-System Safety (OSS)

- FY 2016 132 Approved Commitments
 - \$12 million disbursed
- FY 2017
 - Currently soliciting applications from local governments
 - May 1st deadline to District Engineers
 - Local Match required
 - striping, RPMs, signs, shoulder widening
