




Busy Season last year


- Started

Due to impact on western Georgia

- We expanded metro brine treatment limits to the Alabama line
- Kept traffic flowing on I-20





12 inches of snow impacted Cobb and Carroll Counties





Wednesday January 3rd -Saturday January 6th: Winter Storm Grayson

- Very unusual for D5
- We have a Flexible Response Plan
- Crews from D7, D2, D3, and D4 were sent south to Savannah and other D5 impacted areas





Winter Storm Grayson

- Three to six inches of ice
- In South Georgia
- Governor declared a State of Emergency in 28 counties






Winter Storm Grayson

GDOT assisted Chatham County in clearing Truman Parkway:

- 10 mile section
- Had 2 inches of solid ice
- Was closed to traffic










Winter Storm Grayson


GDOT, our CHAMP Program, and GSP

- Assisted South
 Carolina by treating
 over 80 miles of I-95
 into South Carolina
- Traffic was backed up over 40 miles into Georgia on I-95











Saturday January 6th

- Moved GDOT team from South Georgia back to Atlanta for Winter Weather Response
- Held College Football Championship Game
- President Trump Visit
- Opening day of the legislative session





Presidential Visit College Football National Championship

- Worked with Secret Service and Georgia State Patrol
- Treated Presidential Route
 - From Dobbins Air Reserve Base
 - To Mercedes Benz Stadium





Enhancements

- Leveraging multi-purpose equipment
 - Good investment in our operations
 - F-250 with salt spreader and plow attachments for winter operations.
 - We have increased our fleet to 80
- Private Sector Partners
 - Contractor in place in D7 for winter weather response
- Total of 209,000 gallons in storage at brine farm at MAU
- New statewide herbicide contract awarded
 - Including brine application capabilities in the districts
- 33 5,000 gal brine tankers available (interstate)
- 436 snow plows/spreaders available
- 54,000 tons of salt available with enhancements
- 65,000 tons of gravel available
- 55 Road Weather Information System (RWIS) sensors available





Working diligently with Federal, State, and Local Partners preparing for Super Bowl LIII










Super Bowl Activation GDOT Teams

- SOC will send out route assignments to Team Captains
- Teams will:
 - Load from their district stockpiles and
 - Convoy to their designated route assignment
 - With tracking devices active until the exercise has been concluded
- Teams are to remain on route assignment until SOC changes assignment or deactivates Team
