Assembly

- ✓ SB25—clarifies changes from 2018 for yielding to loading school buses. (Signed by Governor Kemp as Act #1 on February 15th)
- ✓ SB79—updates outdoor advertising code definition of "multimessage."
- ✓ HB454—updates traffic code with "electric assisted bicycle" and defines bicycle by class on the basis of maximum speed; establishes rules of the road by class.
- ✓ SB103—requires two priority parking spaces for veterans at commercial airports.
- ✓ HB311—waives sovereign immunity for declaratory or injunctive relief on constitutional questions.
- ✓ SB2—allows EMCs to offer broadband services/SB17—allows telephone cooperatives to offer broadband services
- ✓ SB66 & HB184—provides uniform small cell (5G tech) application and permitting guidelines for local governments.



Legislation Still Pending for 2nd Session

- ➤ HB511—creates the Department of Mobility & Innovation; abolishes GRTA; attaches ATL & SRTA. IN SENATE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE
- ➤ HB447—jet fuel sales tax exemption to 06/30/39 & ½¢ per gallon excise imposition. Last amended to include (1) Major Airports Authority Act; (2) exemption sunset changed to 06/30/24; (3) excise rate changed to 10¢ per gallon with annual inflation index adjustment. IN SENATE FINANCE COMMITTEE
- ➤ SB131—creation of the GA Major Airport Authority. Last amended to include (1) Replaces authority with Major Airport Legislative Oversight Committee; (2) HB 447; (3) HB 511; (4) Modified GDOT 10 Year Plan. IN SENATE
- ➤ SB200—Requires GDOT to formalize rules on rejected bid appeal procedure. Last amended to include (1) SB 200; (2) HB 447; (3) HB 511 (Modified w/ SRTA attached to GDOT but DMI Director also SRTA Director. IN CONFERENCE COMMITTEE; CONFEREES: SENATORS GOOCH, B. JONES, HARPER & REPRESENTATIVES TANNER, SMYRE, KNIGHT
- ➤ HB276—"Marketplace facilitator" bill to clarify commercial sales tax liability. HOUSE DISAGREED to SENATE AMENDMENT



Study Committees

✓ HR37—Georgia Commission on Freight & Logistics

Membership (22 Total Members)

- 3 Senators appointed by Lt. Governor (including Transportation Committee Chair)
- 3 Representatives by the Speaker (including Transportation Committee Chair)
- 6 Members (3 appointed by Speaker, 3 appointed by Lt. Gov) "who represent entities who provide freight and logistics services; possess expertise in the operations of a major airport hub; or lead a major commodity shipper, major air shipping provider, or major manufacturing operation based in this state"
- 4 Members (2 appointed by Speaker, 2 appointed by Lt. Gov) who are local government officials.
- Exec. Directors of ACCG and GMA
- President/Chairperson of the Georgia & Metro Atlanta Chambers of Commerce
- GDOT Commissioner
- Georgia Ports Authority Executive Director

- Assessment of "the best course of action with regard to funding and policy."


