

GDOT's Streamlining efforts

Simplified EPD's Stream Buffer Variance process

Reduced process time by 4-6 weeks for GDOT & local projects

Save resources by avoiding duplicate steps





GDOT's Streamlining Efforts

Programmatic Agreement with FHWA

- Programmatic Categorical Exclusion
- FHWA Recently completed an Audit revealed <u>no</u> major issues

 This will hopefully lead to more projects being able to be covered under a future agreement.





GDOT's Streamlining efforts

Programmatic Air Quality Analyses for Carbon Monoxide Agreement with EPA and FHWA (April 2017):

- Reduces costs by eliminating intensive air quality analyses
- ➤ Analyses that used to take a month or more to complete, are now completed in less than a day





GDOT's Streamlining efforts

Reevaluation Agreement:

- ➤ 25 Reevaluations were able to be approved without requiring FHWA signature
- > Several no change re-certifications were eliminated

> Time and money savings
