



#### Major Mobility Investment Program (MMIP) Overview

Passage of the Transportation Funding Act (TFA) has allowed the Georgia Department of Transportation (Georgia DOT) to make major investments in Georgia's transportation network. Under the Major Mobility Investment Program (MMIP), an initial list of 11 large-scale transportation projects will improve mobilit Georgia's metro areas and provide overall improvements to quality of life for commuters.






