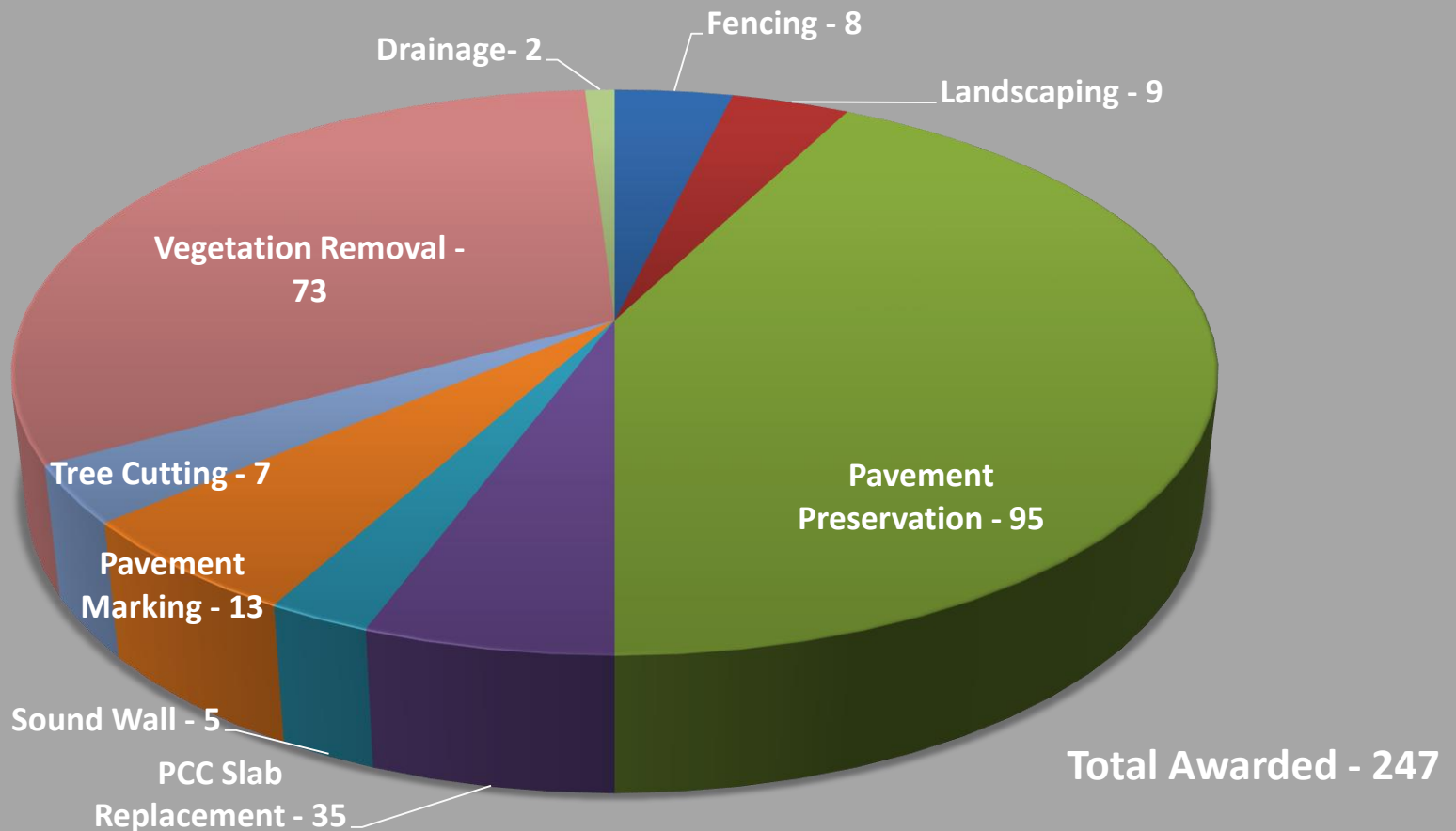

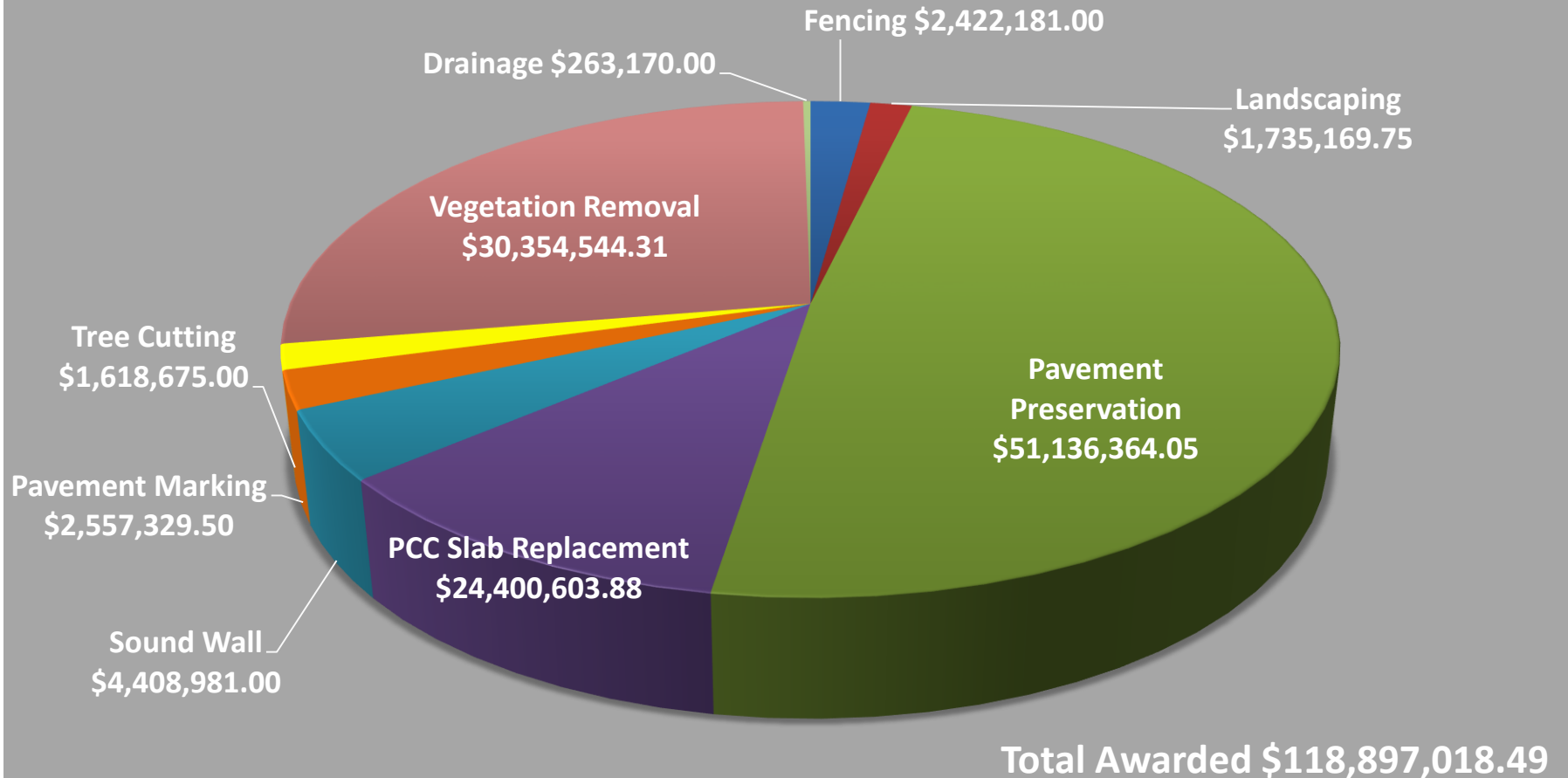
ITBs By the Numbers

Number of ITBs Awarded per Category for FY2018



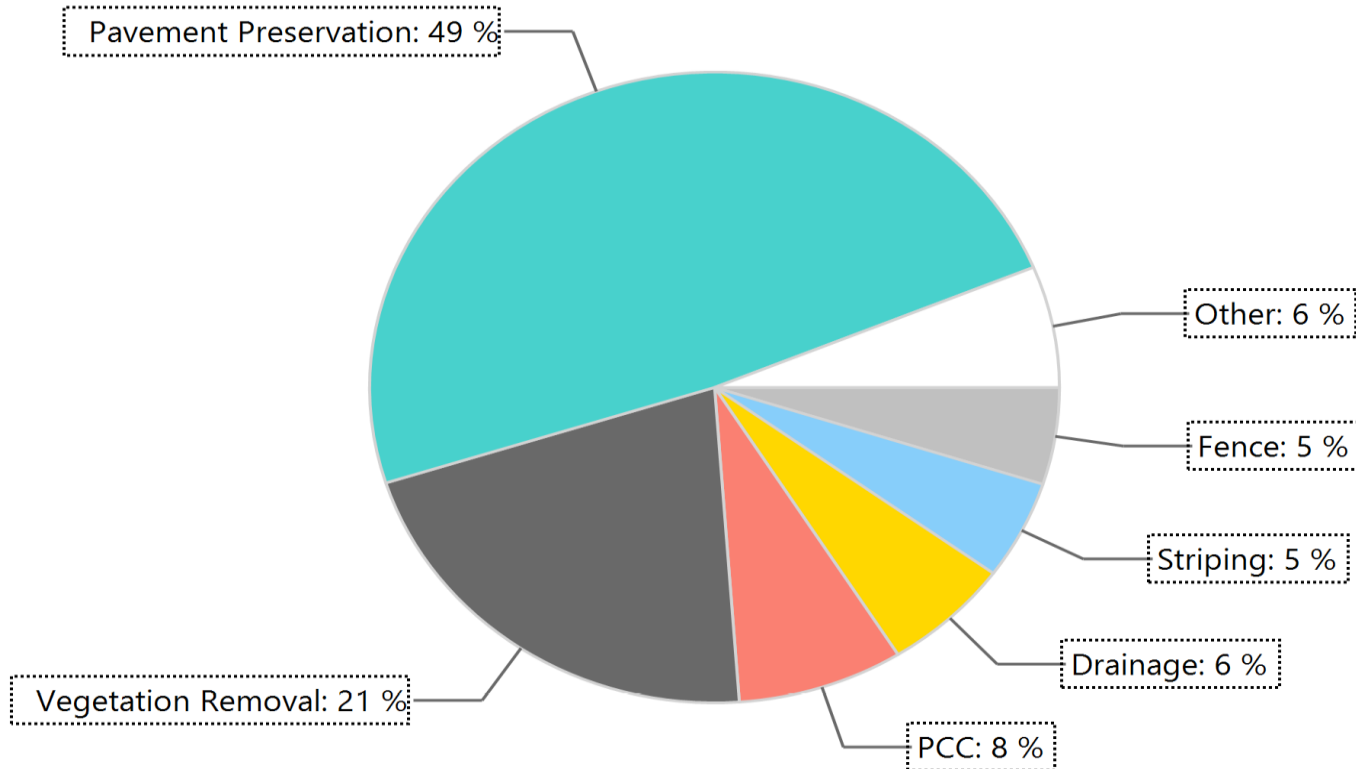
ITBs By the Numbers

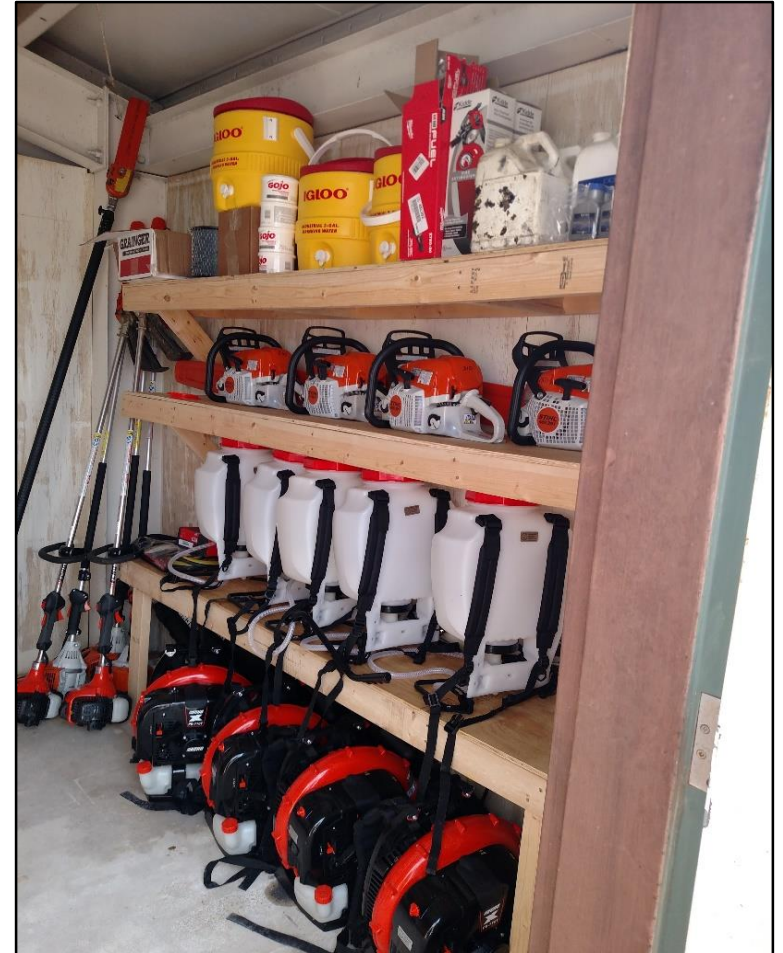

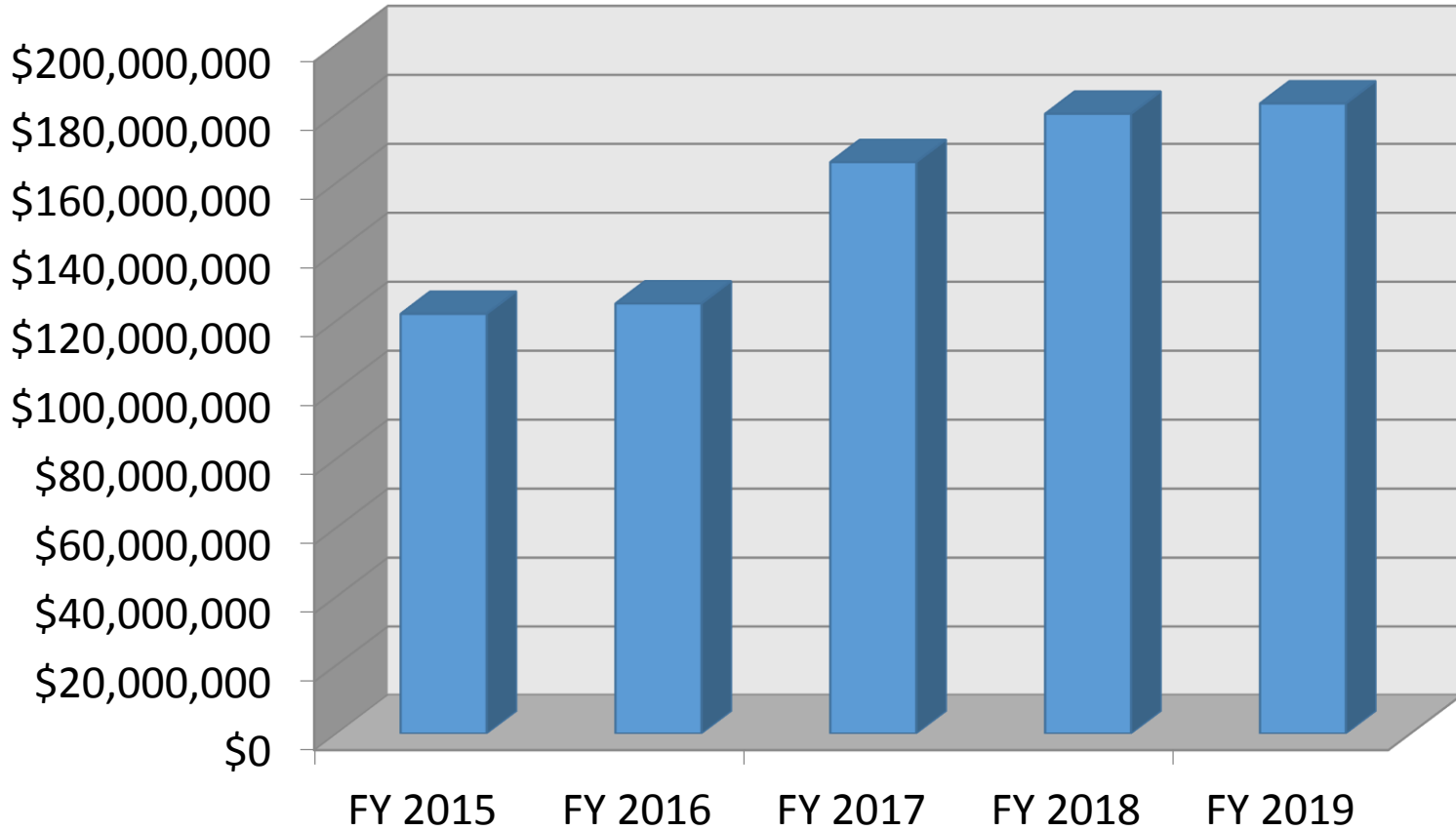

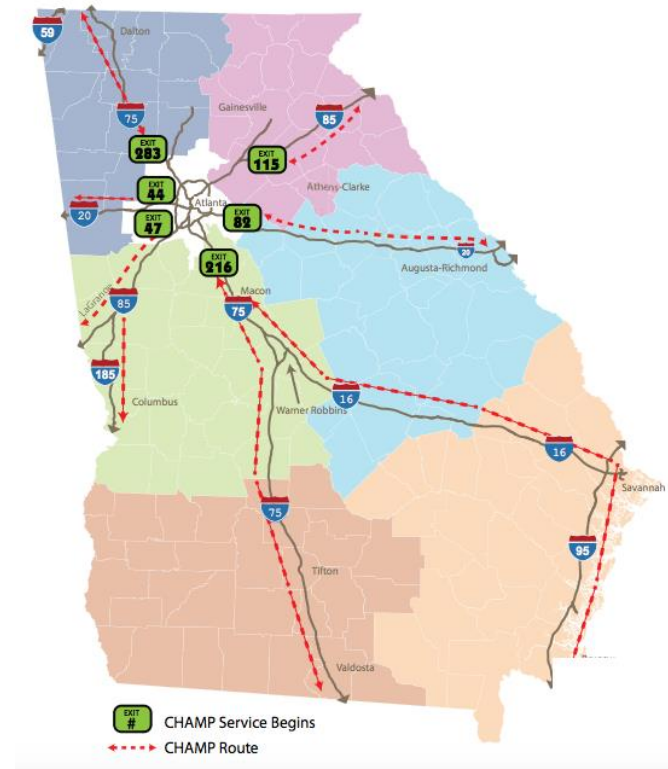
