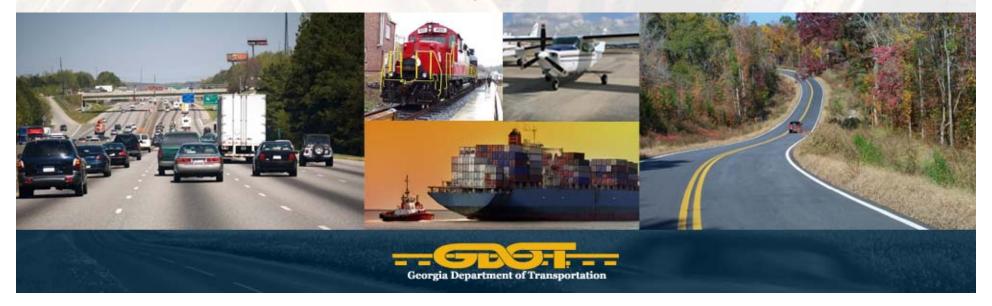

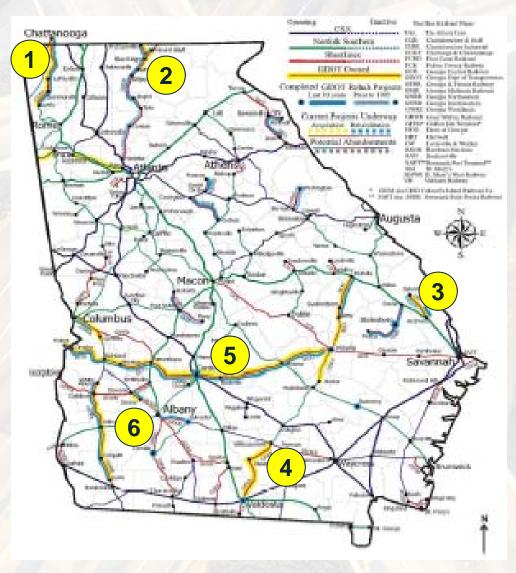


All Freight Rail in Georgia: The 2009 "Big Picture"

- > 5,000 miles of track
- 2 Mainlines (NS and CSX)
- > 25 Shortlines
- > 121,000 "Logistics Providers" jobs
- > \$15.6 billion in Logistics Providers sales
- > 30% growth over next 20 years in freight rail volume
- Critical connect modals within total Georgia, Southeastern and Nationwide freight systems

Summary of Key Impacts

- > Significant job creation in areas of the State most in need.
- Substantial positive "return on investment" with respect to State tax revenues generated by rail improvements.
- ➤ High impact (1.74 multiplier effect) on other areas of a county's economy.
- Excellent economic tool for re-energizing manufacturing base in counties and communities throughout the State.
- Positioning for future with respect to national and regional freight growth, Savannah port growth, and Statewide rail system for both freight and passenger rail.
