- 1) The contest will accept entries from September 16 November 15, 2019. One (1) entry will be accepted per participant.
- 2) All participants must be:
 - a. Ages 5 12
 - Residents of any of the following 31 Counties: Bibb, Butts, Chattahoochee, Coweta, Crawford, Dooly, Fayette, Harris, Heard, Henry, Houston, Jones, Lamar, Macon, Marion, Meriwether, Monroe, Muscogee, Peach, Pike, Pulaski, Schley, Spalding, Stewart, Sumter, Talbot, Taylor, Troup, Twiggs, Upson, Webster
- 3) Three winners will be selected each week while prizes last and their entries featured on the Georgia DOT District 3 (West Central Georgia region) Facebook and Twitter pages. The posts will ONLY feature the participants' names, ages and hometowns (NO street addresses will be listed online). Winners will also receive a SEE & BE SEEN water bottle.
- 4) Participants must include their names, ages, and addresses with their entries, but this information will ONLY be used if they are a weekly winner and need to be mailed a prize. Personal information will NOT be stored in any database or site and will not be used for ANY other reason.
- 5) Winners will be chosen based on the entry's creativity and must reflect the contest theme. All decisions are at the discretion of the Georgia DOT.
