

Exit Relocation: SR 400 Northbound to Abernathy Road (Exit 5B)



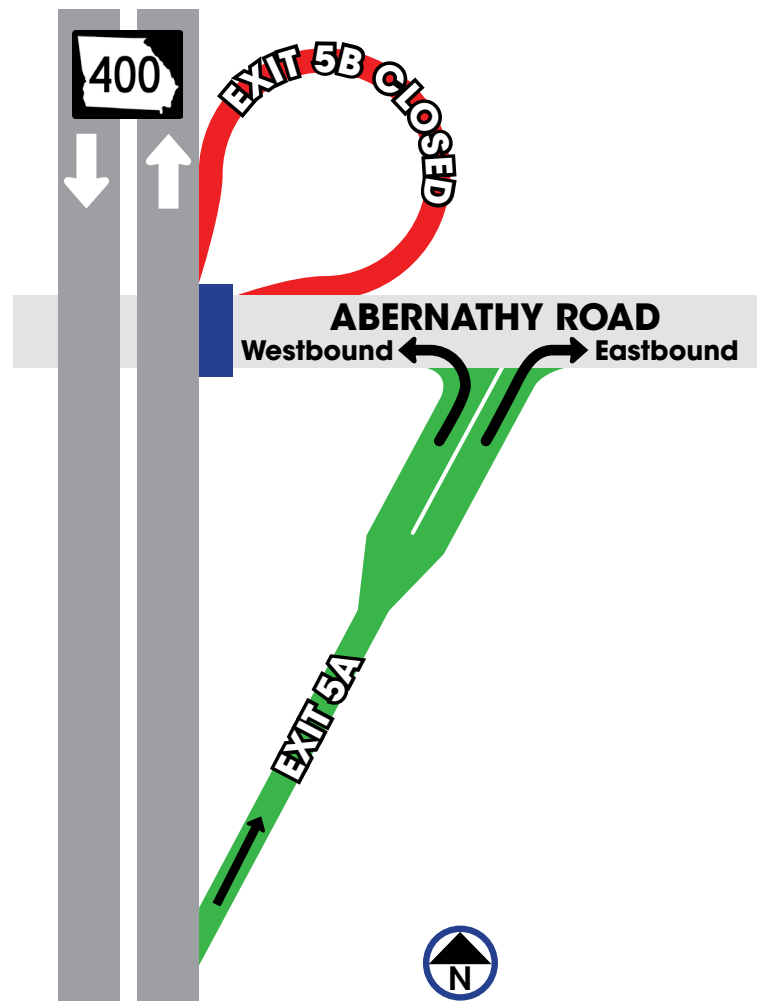
The Transform 285/400 project team will close and relocate the exit on SR 400 northbound to Abernathy Road westbound (Exit 5B). This closure will be permanent and the new exit configuration will be combined with the existing Abernathy Road eastbound exit (5A). The closure of Exit 5B will allow the project team to begin construction on a collector-distributor (CD) bridge over Abernathy Road.

The closure will take place in **Q2 2020**.

Things to Know

- The SR 400 northbound exit to Abernathy Road westbound (Exit 5B) will permanently close to motorists.
- The Abernathy Road exits will now be combined. Motorists will use the SR 400 northbound exit to Abernathy Road eastbound (Exit 5A) to travel to Abernathy Road westbound.
- Signage will be in place to help motorists navigate the new configuration of the exit.
- Motorists should pay close attention to the new exit configuration.
- The SR 400 southbound exit to Abernathy Road will not be impacted by the construction on a CD bridge over Abernathy Road.
