

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Douglasville has worked with the Georgia Department of Transportation, the Atlanta Regional Commission, and the Federal Highway Administration for several years on what is locally known as the Georgia Highway 92 Relocation Project; and

WHEREAS, this project now starts just south of Durelee Lane within the City of Douglasville and continues north through the City of Douglasville, ending at Nebo Road in Paulding County; and

WHEREAS, GDOT's identification of the planned improvements on Georgia Highway 92 within the parameters described above is: Projects STP00-0186-01(011), CSSTP-0006-00(900)(901), and CSSTP-0007-00(691); Douglas and Paulding Counties; P.I. Nos. 720970, 0006900, 0006901, and 0007691 – The Widening and Realignment of SR 92 from South of Durelee Lane to Nebo Road; and

WHEREAS, the City of Douglasville has used its General Fund revenues and money from a Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) to pay for preliminary engineering and to meet the environmental requirements for this federally funded project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Douglasville has received comments from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) as it relates to the draft Environmental Assessment.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Douglasville that we are in support of the proposed project and associated mitigation plan developed by our consultant, Croy Engineering, that includes upgraded pedestrian facilities at the proposed intersection of Colquitt Street and the New Highway 92 which includes an upgraded pedestrian notification system and vegetative deterrent buffers which would be planted to encourage crossing only at designated areas.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council that we are committed to maintaining pedestrian access to schools, our local parks and other typical pedestrian routes throughout the City of Douglasville.
