

I-85 Express Lanes Extension

FACT SHEET

What is the Project?

The I-85 Express Lanes Extension are part of a network of new optional toll lanes designed to improve mobility and provide more reliable trip times throughout Metro Atlanta. The project will add 10 miles of newly constructed managed lanes, north of the existing I-85 Express Lanes, entirely in Gwinnett County. The extension project will begin on I-85 at Old Peachtree Road to Hamilton Mill Road. The Express Lanes will feature dynamic priced tolling, rising as demand increases during peak travel times and falling at off-peak times, giving drivers the choice to pay a toll to bypass congestion. In addition to the toll lanes, new auxiliary lanes will be constructed to help keep traffic moving in the congested areas of the corridor.

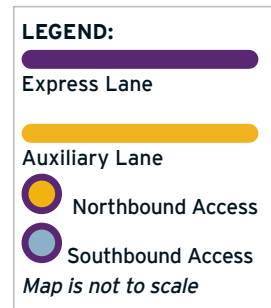
Benefits

- Reliable trip times for drivers and transit riders
- Enhancements to transportation infrastructure supporting economic development
- Toll-free for transit and registered vanpool customers

5 Things to Know

1. To use the Express Lanes, drivers must have a registered Peach Pass through the State Road and Tollway Authority (SRTA). Peach Passes can be obtained at peachpass.com
2. One northbound and one southbound toll lane will operate north of the existing I-85 Express Lanes.
3. Auxiliary lanes will provide better traffic flow between key interchanges: I-85 southbound from SR 20 to SR 317/Lawrenceville Suwanee and I-85 northbound from SR 20 to SR 324/Gravel Springs Road overpass
4. Total project estimated cost is \$178 million
5. Delivery method: P3 Design-Build
