All comments will be made a part of the project record. We hope you will take advantage of one of these opportunities to let GDOT know your view of the proposal.

The displays and plans will be available for review for ten days after the public information open house at the Georgia Department of Transportation Office of Environment Services located at 600 West Peachtree Street NW, 16th Floor, Atlanta, Georgia 30308 and at the Georgia Department of Transportation District 1 Office 2505 Athens Hwy SE, Gainesville, GA 30507. A copy of all comments received will be available for public review at these same locations and at the Georgia Department of Transportation, Office of Environment Services, 600 West Peachtree Street NW, 16th Floor, Atlanta, Georgia 30308, as soon as compilation is completed.
