Subject: Senate Bill 200 Progress Reports

OCGA 32-2-41.2 requires the Director of Planning to submit an annual report to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Chairmen of the House and Senate Transportation Committees, detailing the status of projects valued in excess of \$10 million. There is also a requirement that an annual report be delivered concerning Value Engineering savings and a bi-annual Progress Report on the Statewide Strategic Transportation Plan, which will be provided in December 2015.
