

## **What is the STIP?**

The **Statewide Transportation Improvement Program**, also known as the STIP, is Georgia's four-year transportation and capital improvements program. The STIP lists federally-funded transportation projects that are located outside Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) boundaries. Projects include highway, bridge, public transit, bike, pedestrian, railroad, and other improvements.

## **How is the STIP Developed?**

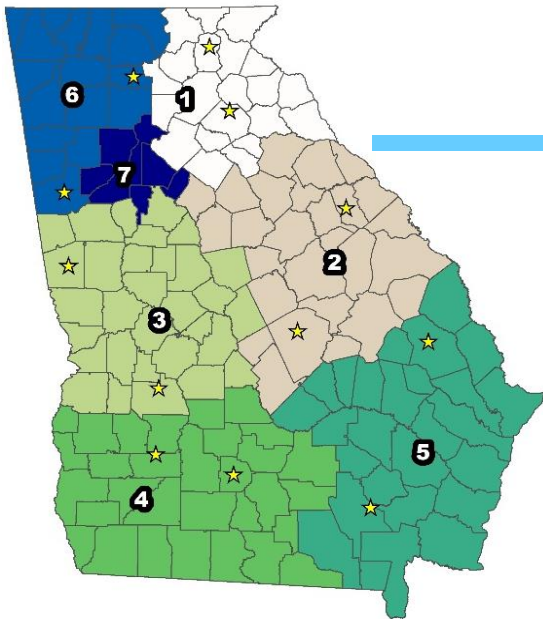
The STIP is developed in coordination with the citizens of Georgia, interested stakeholders, and in direct cooperation with local governments. Projects listed in the STIP are identified through GDOT's ongoing planning processes in keeping with the Governor's Strategic Goals for Georgia to provide a lean and responsive state government that allows communities, individuals, and businesses to prosper. These projects are vital to supporting GDOT's mission in providing a safe, seamless, and sustainable transportation system that supports Georgia's economy and is sensitive to its citizens and the environment.

## **Why Should I Become Involved?**

The STIP Public Involvement Process gives all citizens and interested stakeholders the opportunity to review and comment on the State's transportation priorities for the next four fiscal years. The public is encouraged to become involved and provide GDOT with thoughts, suggestions, and information about transportation needs for Georgia.
