SUBJECT: Temporary Pavements for Minor Pavement Projects

Projects that meet the criteria of the <u>Minor Pavement Project Guidelines (MPPG)</u> can use the following temporary pavement designs and do not require the review and approval of the State Pavement Engineer.

Temporary Pavements for Minor Projects						
Service Life	MPG Section Code	9.5mm SP type II	19mm SP	25mm SP	GAB	
Less than 1 year	Α	0"	2"	0"	6"	
Less than 1 year	B, C	0"	2"	0"	8"	
Less than 1 year	D, E	0"	3"	0"	8"	
1-2 years	A, B	1.25"	2"	0"	6"	
1-2 years	С	1.25"	2"	0"	8"	
1-2 years	D, E	1.25"	3"	0"	8"	
2+ years	ALL	1.25"	2"	3"	6"	

All other projects that require a temporary pavement should include the temporary pavement design with the Pavement Design Package or Pavement Evaluation Summary for review and approval.

These guidelines are for immediate implementation and supersede the previous temporary pavement standards.
