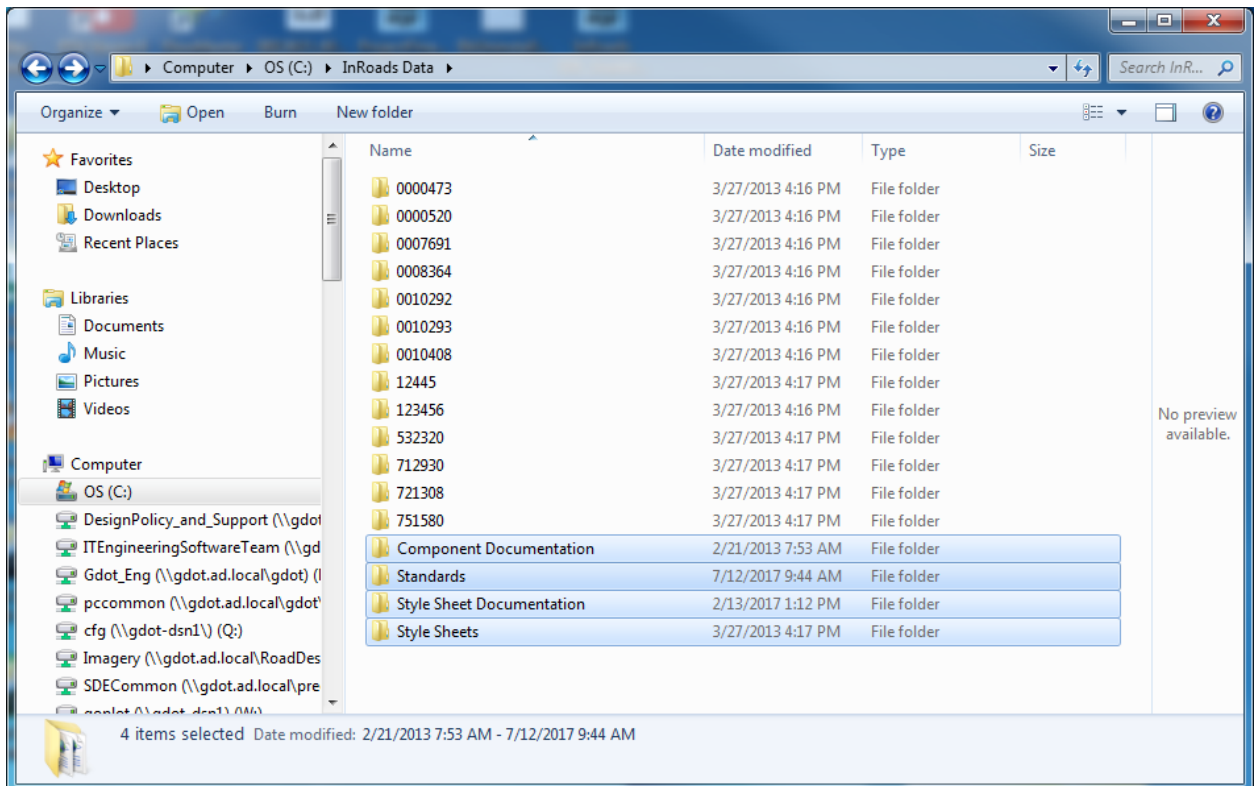
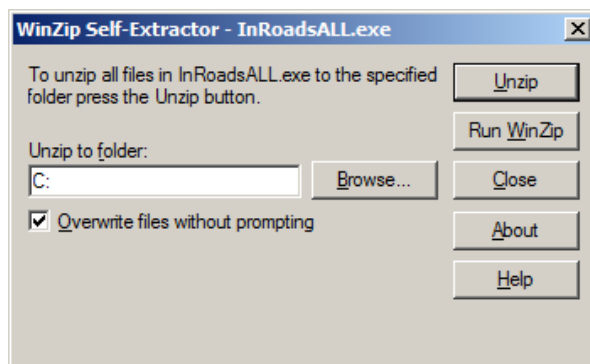


## Downloading and Running InRoadsALL.exe

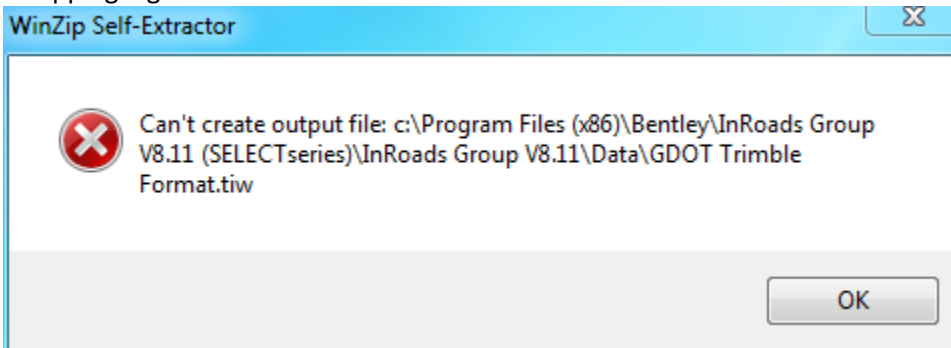
1. Prior to downloading, you should **carefully** clean out your C:\InRoads Data subfolders to ensure you do not have older versions of files that have been superseded with newer files with different file names. **You should be able to safely delete the four highlighted folders below.** If you have any custom InRoads Preferences, Drafting Notes, or Templates that you wish to keep, you should **not** be saving these in the files in the Standards folder here. Instead, use ProjectWise or else any location other than the four highlighted folders below. For instructions on adding your customized InRoads Preferences back into an updated .XIN file, see the [Using InRoads in ProjectWise](#) document on the ROADS webpage.



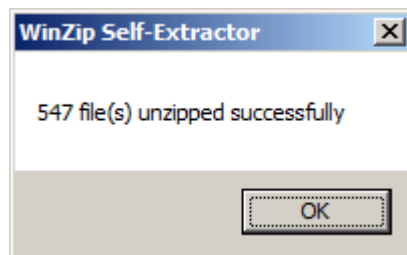
2. Download InRoadsALL.exec to your desktop.
3. Rename InRoadsALL.exec to InRoadsALL.exe.
4. From the Desktop, double click on InRoadsALL.exe and the following window will appear.



5. Leave c:\ as the folder to unzip to. (If you are working from a drive other than c:\ such as d:\, replace c:\ with d:\) All files will be placed in the correct subfolder and a subfolder will be created if necessary.
6. Insure the Checkbox 'Overwrite files without prompting' contains a check mark.
7. Click Unzip. If you receive the following error message, click OK and the files will finish unzipping. Ignore this error.



8. The files will unzip to their proper locations and a message will appear similar to that shown here.



9. Click OK.
10. Close the the WinZip Self-Extractor.
11. Delete the InRoadsALL.exe from your desktop.
