

SUMMARY OF GDOT DESIGN-BUILD PROJECTS FISCAL YEAR 2010

The total bid award amount for all GDOT Design-Build contracts in FY 2010 was \$39,593,628.18. Below are the descriptions of the Design-Build projects awarded to construction in FY 2010.

Design-Build Project 2010-1

Federal Project Number: CSSTP-0008-00(651), Chatham County

PI Number: 0008651

Project description:

The project includes the construction of a 2-lane high rise bridge over Skidaway Narrows and approaches along SR 204 Spur/Diamond Causeway in Chatham County to replace the existing bridge. The current crossing at Skidaway Narrows is via 2-lane bascule bridge (Structure ID# 051-0147-0), which has a bridge sufficiency rate of 45.00, and is near the end of its service life. The total length of the project (bridge and approaches) is 1.25 miles.

This contract was awarded to the low-bid proposal submitted by United Contractors / The LPA Group for a total contract amount of \$22,489,997.00.

The Notice to Proceed was issued on December 4, 2009 and the contract completion date is July 31, 2013.

Design-Build Project 2010-2

Federal Project Number: CSNHS-0006-00 (043), Cherokee County

PI Number: 0006043

Project description:

The project includes the construction of a new, full-diamond interchange where Ridgewalk Parkway currently overpasses I-575 between the existing interchanges at Towne Lake Parkway and Sixes Road. The project would also provide auxiliary lanes on I-575 from Towne Lake Parkway to Ridgewalk Parkway and would realign Old Rope Mill Road, north of Ridgewalk Parkway. The total project length would be approximately 9,300 feet (1.76 miles).

This contract was awarded to the low-bid proposal submitted by C.W. Mathews Contracting, Inc. / The LPA Group for a total contract amount of \$17,103,631.18.

The Notice to Proceed was issued on April 28, 2010 and the contract completion date is December 31, 2012.
