## **NIGHTTIME DOUBLE LANE CLOSURE ON I-75 NORTHBOUND FOR ROAD REPAIR**

**WHEN:** 9 p.m., Saturday, October 22 until 6 a.m., Sunday, October 23, weather permitting

**WHERE:** I-75 northbound at mile marker 227 (Exit 227; I-675)

**WHAT:** Georgia DOT Maintenance crews have scheduled a double lane closure on I-75 northbound at the I-675 split. Crews will be making roadway repairs in the 2 outside travel lanes.

This is a **WORK ZONE** and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this construction work zone. Message signs, barrels and cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

Motorists can access real-time, statewide, route-specific information on accidents, road work, traffic and weather conditions through **Georgia 511** - a free phone, web, and mobile service. By dialing 511, callers also can transfer to operators 24 hours a day to report incidents or request assistance. The system can be used to access transit providers, major airports, rideshare organizations, tourism information and 511 systems in surrounding states. Additionally, 511 is available online or as a hybrid solution via a free download for your smart phone.
