TRAFFIC SHIFT SCHEDULED ON STATE ROUTE 34

WHEN: 10 a.m., Wednesday, June 1

WHERE: SR 34 between Roscoe Road and Jackson Street

WHAT: The Georgia DOT has been notified by the contractor of a traffic shift on SR 34. Traffic will be shifted from the old pavement to the newly paved lanes. The traffic pattern will shift between SR 70 (Roscoe Road) and SR 14/US 29 (Jackson Street).

This project consists of 4.120 miles of widening and reconstruction on SR 34 Bypass, beginning at US 27/SR 16 and extending to SR 34 (Bullsboro Drive); it also includes construction of a total of two bridges and approaches over the CSX Railroad and installation of an Intersection Detection System. This project is scheduled to be completed by December 31, 2011.

This is a **WORK ZONE** and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this construction work zone. Message signs, barrels and cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.
