GEORGIA DOT ANNOUNCES LANE CLOSURES FOR U.S. 17/S.R. 25

WHEN: Daily, between 9 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday September 12, 2011 and continuing thru Thursday, September 15, 2011(weather permitting).

WHERE: U.S.17/S.R.25 between 4th St. and Talmadge Ave.

WHAT: Georgia Department of Transportation Maintenance crews have scheduled lane closures at several locations on U.S.17/S.R. 25 between 4th St. and Talmadge Ave. in Glynn County. These temporary lane closures are scheduled daily between 9 a.m.to 3:30 p.m., Monday September 12, 2011 and continuing through Thursday, September 15, weather permitting. Southbound motorists could encounter either a right or left lane closure throughout the week. These lane closures will be utilized for milling and resurfacing operations.

This is a **WORK ZONE** and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this work zone.

Each day, hundreds of Georgia Department of Transportation employees and contractors work on dozens of highway, bridge and intersection improvements throughout the state. Their work often brings them and heavy machinery in close proximity to travel lanes. Fifty-seven Georgia DOT personnel and many more motorists, passengers and contractors' workers have been killed in highway work zone accidents since 1973. Please help us prevent these tragedies by slowing down; being especially attentive and cautious as you pass through construction work zones; and always driving responsibly.
