## **GEORGIA DOT ANNOUNCES LANE CLOSURES ON U.S. 341/ S.R. 27**

**WHEN:** Daily, between 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Thursday, September 1 and also Tuesday, September 6 continuing through Thursday, September 8, weather permitting.

**WHERE:** S.R. 27/U.S. 341 between Old Jesup Hwy to I-95.

**WHAT:** Georgia Department of Transportation Maintenance crews have scheduled lane closures near the Burnett Creek Bridge on U.S.341/S.R. 27 between Old Jesup Hwy. and I-95. These temporary lane closures are scheduled daily between 9 a.m.to 3:30 p.m., Thursday, September 1 and also Tuesday, September 6 continuing through Thursday, September 8, weather permitting. East and westbound motorists could encounter either a right or left lane closure. These lane closures will be utilized for approach work at the Burnett Creek Bridge.

This is a **WORK ZONE** and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this work zone.

Each day, hundreds of Georgia Department of Transportation employees and contractors work on dozens of highway, bridge and intersection improvements throughout the state. Their work often brings them and heavy machinery in close proximity to travel lanes. Fifty-seven Georgia DOT personnel and many more motorists, passengers and contractors' workers have been killed in highway work zone accidents since 1973. Please help us prevent these tragedies by slowing down; being especially attentive and cautious as you pass through construction work zones; and always driving responsibly.
