Weather Did Not Cooperate Gainesville Traffic Shift Rescheduled

Gainesville, Ga. – Weather has not cooperated with planned road work. The planned traffic shift on Highway 369/Browns Bridge Road scheduled for tomorrow is delayed for one week to November 10. Please use extra caution as crews finish up the necessary work.

What: Cresswind is improving safety and access within their Community by building a tunnel to carry traffic under SR 369 connecting the Community that spreads on both sides of the highway.

Why: Traffic will be shifted back to the original location of SR 369. Traffic is now shifted south to give room for a new bridge to be built that will allow Cresswind Parkway to be extended under SR 369/Browns Bridge Road. Georgia DOT approved the design through permit and is supervising the work because it affects State Route 369. This work is coordinated with the future widening of SR 369.

When: Weather delayed the work needed prior to the traffic shift. The traffic shift is now planned for Tuesday, November 10, 2015 if weather cooperates.

Where: State Route 369/Browns Bridge Road from Keith Bridge Road to Montgomery Drive.
