Barrier Wall Construction Continues Requiring Westbound Lane Closure on SR 204/Abercorn Street

WHAT: Contractors for Georgia DOT will be installing a westbound right lane closure on S.R. 204/Abercorn Street between King George Boulevard and Pine Grove Road in Chatham County. This closure will be utilized for the concrete barrier wall construction and has been scheduled weekdays from 7 a.m. until 4 p.m. on Friday, Monday and Tuesday. All work is weather contingent. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes.

This is a WORK ZONE and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this construction work zone. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

WHEN: 7 a.m. until 4 p.m., Friday, February 26, Monday, February 29 and Tuesday, March 1, weather permitting.

WHERE: S.R.204/Abercorn Street, westbound right/outside lane between King George Boulevard and Pine Grove Road in Chatham County.
