WORKING ON THE WEEKEND...

Contractor Schedules Lane and Ramp Closures on I-75 North and Southbound

WHEN: Various times beginning Saturday, September 21, through Sunday, September 22, weather permitting

WHERE: I-75 north and southbound between Exit 167; Pierce Avenue and Exit 169; Arkwright Road

WHAT: The Georgia DOT has been notified by the contractor of a scheduled lane closures on I-75 north and southbound. Work will begin at various times as described below:

- **9 p.m., Friday, September 27 through 6 a.m., Monday, September 30:** I-75 northbound on-ramp from Exit 167, Pierce Avenue
- Saturday, September 21 daily until Sunday, September 22: 6 a.m. until 11 p.m., inside lanes of I-75 north and southbound for paving operations between Pierce Avenue and Arkwright Road

This is a WORK ZONE and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this construction work zone. Message boards, barrels and cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming traffic changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

*Motorists can access real-time, statewide, route-specific information on accidents, road work, traffic and weather conditions through **Georgia 511** - a free phone service. By dialing 511, callers also can transfer to operators to 24 hours a day to report incidents or request assistance. The system can be used to access transit providers, major airports, rideshare organizations, tourism information and 511 systems in surrounding states. Additionally, 511 is available online.
