**GUARDRAIL REPAIRS SCHEDULED THIS WEEK ON GEORGIA’S INTERSTATES**

**WHEN:** Daily at various times, Thursday, May 30 and Friday, May 31, weather permitting

**WHERE:** I-75 north and southbound in Bibb and I-85 northbound in Coweta and Troup

**WHAT:** Contractors for the Georgia DOT have scheduled lane and shoulder closures for guardrail repairs in Bibb, Coweta and Spalding Counties at the following locations:

**Bibb County**

I-75 north and southbound between mile markers 152 and 153, Thursday, May 30, 8 a.m. until 5 p.m., near Exit 149 (SR 49)

**Coweta County**

I-85 northbound at mile marker 44, Friday, May 31, 8 a.m. until 11 a.m., near Exit 41 (SR 14 / US 27 Alt)

**Troup County**

I-85 northbound at mile marker 5, Friday, May 31, 11 a.m. until 4 p.m., near Exit 2 (SR 18)

Crews will be working in half mile to 1 mile increments and relocating frequently. Motorists should be alert to changing work patterns.

This is a WORK ZONE and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this maintenance work zone. Message signs, barrels and cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.
