ROBERT L. BROWN, JR. RE-ELECTED TO TRANSPORTATION BOARD

ATLANTA- Business, community and civic leader Robert Brown was re-elected to the State Transportation Board on Wednesday by a caucus of state representatives and senators from the 4th Congressional District, comprised of DeKalb, Gwinnett, Newton and Rockdale counties. His new term begins April 16, 2016.

Brown is a 10-year board veteran, and is currently board vice chairman. He serves on numerous committees including Statewide Transportation Planning/Strategic Planning; Administrative; Finance; Intermodal; and Public Private Partnerships (P3). He was previously board secretary.

“Serving on the State Transportation Board for the last decade has been an honor and I am pleased to continue in that capacity,”

Brown said. “This is an especially exciting time for transportation in Georgia. The state funding resulting from the Transportation Funding Act will provide GDOT with sustainable revenue to allow us to improve and maintain Georgia’s road and bridge infrastructure, and to advance transportation throughout the state.”

A Dublin native, Brown resides in Decatur. The Tuskegee University graduate is a registered architect, and president and CEO of an architectural and construction management firm.

Brown is active in numerous community and civic organizations including the American Institute of Architects; Georgia Partnership for Excellence in Education; Southern Polytechnic State University and Georgia Perimeter College Foundation Boards; Agnes Scott College Board of Trustees; and Smart Start Georgia. Brown is a member of the Georgia Chamber of Commerce, Metro Atlanta Chamber of Commerce and the Decatur Business Association.

The 14-member State Transportation Board determines policy and generally governs the Georgia Department of Transportation. Each member is elected by a caucus of Georgia General Assembly members from their specific congressional district. Board members serve staggered, five-year terms.
