Resurfacing Project Under Way on SR 333

What: Georgia Department of Transportation contractor The Scruggs Co. of Hahira has started a project to resurface state Route 333 and add 2-foot paved shoulders from the Florida state line into downtown Quitman. The road is being resurfaced because it has deteriorated. The existing shoulder is unpaved, which results in deterioration of the edge of the asphalt, especially when large trucks run off the road.

The contractor has started outside the Quitman downtown area and is working south building the shoulder. The majority of the work will be done during the day, but the contractor is restricted from closing lanes in the downtown Quitman area during the day, so that section will be done at night.

The distance of the project is 12 miles, the construction cost is \$2.39 million and the completion date is March 2017. Please slow down if you approach the contractor's crew, be patient and obey traffic control.

When: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday with the potential for weekend work (downtown Quitman area will be night work)

Where: SR 333 from the Florida state line to U.S. 84/SR 38 in Quitman, Brooks County
