## **RAIN DELAY - TRAFFIC SHIFT RESCHEDULED FOR TOMORROW ON US 129/SR 11 CONNECTOR AT THE CLEVELAND BYPASS IN WHITE COUNTY**

GAINESVILLE, Ga. – The Georgia Department of Transportation (DOT) announces the traffic shift on US 129 Connector at the West Cleveland Bypass planned for today is delayed by rain. Crews will shift traffic tomorrow, Wednesday, June 10, 2015 if weather permits.

Traffic on US 129 Connector will be shifted slightly to the east to accommodate the new alignment of the highway with the West Cleveland Bypass.

This realignment operation and traffic shift are part of a 1.970 mile project to construct the West Cleveland Bypass. Work on this project began late August 2012.
