## **Detour Around Upcoming Drainage Work at Broad and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street**

**WHAT:** The Georgia Department of Transportation wants those travelers coming through the State Route 28 (Broad Street) and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street intersection area to be aware of a detour scheduled to start at **9:30 a.m. Tuesday, June 16** and possibly run through **Thursday, June 18**. Maintenance crews are repairing a damaged storm drain pipe in the area. Georgia DOT will have signage in place Monday, June 15 in anticipation of the detour.

Those traveling on Broad Street will use E. Boundary Street, Greene Street and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street as the main detour. A route taking Bay Street and Forsyth Street will be signed as well for additional access to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Street area.

**WHEN:** If weather cooperates, the detour begins at 9:30 a.m. Tuesday, June 16 and could last through the end of the week.

**WHERE:** The Broad Street and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street intersection in downtown Augusta.
