Daytime Traffic Paces Planned on I-75 and I-575 for Rock Blasting during Northwest Corridor Construction

WHAT: Weather permitting, Georgia DOT construction partners will conduct daytime traffic pacing on I-75 northbound and southbound, as well as on I-575 southbound, for rock blasting related to Northwest Corridor Express Lanes bridge construction.

WHEN: Friday, June 23, between 12 p.m. – 2 p.m.

WHERE: **I-75 Northbound Traffic Pace** – From North Marietta Parkway to the I-75/I-575 interchange

I-75 Southbound Traffic Pace – From Frey Road to the I-75/I-575 interchange

I-575 Southbound Traffic Pace – From Bells Ferry Road to the I-75/I-575 interchange

ADVISORY: Exact dates may change due to weather or other factors. Motorists are advised to expect delays, exercise caution, and reduce their speed while traveling through work zones.
