Cobb County.... Detour Planned at the I-75 Northbound Exit Ramp to I-285 Westbound CD Lanes

WHAT: Weather permitting, a nighttime detour for bridge work within the NWC Express Lanes project corridor will occur impacting access to the I-285 Westbound Collector Distributor Lanes.

WHEN: 9 p.m. Tuesday, April 25 until 5 a.m. Wednesday, April 26

WHERE: I-75 Northbound Exit Ramp to I-285 Westbound CD Lanes – I-75 Northbound motorists will be directed to exit at Windy Hill Road (exit 260). Motorists will then be directed to turn left onto Windy Hill Road followed by a left turn to enter I-75 Southbound. From there, motorists can merge onto I-285 Westbound and continue travel.

ADVISORY: Motorists are advised to expect delays and exercise caution while driving in these areas. On-site message boards indicating dates and times will be present in advance of these closures.

Georgia DOT, its developer partners and contractors are adjusting construction activities to reduce travel impacts to motorists during the I-85 closure. For the latest information on the I-85 bridge reconstruction, detours and travel alternatives, <u>click here</u>.
