### **Double traffic shift for remaining Fall Line Freeway construction**

SANDERSVILLE- By the end of the Wednesday, Nov. 2 business day, State Route (SR) 24 drivers will experience a double traffic shift at Panther Branch Road and Smith Robinson Road.

The Washington County Fall Line Freeway (FLF) progress allows G.P.'s Enterprises Inc. to construct final eastbound lanes between these two locations.

Georgia DOT anticipates work on the shift will begin around 9 a.m. next Wednesday and be fully implemented by 5 p.m. Citizens should expect a pilot car and flagging operation as paving activities and striping get completed in this area.

Both active FLF projects cover 16 miles from near Stenbridge Road in Baldwin County to Indian Trail Road in Washington County and then east from there to SR 68. The public will experience traffic shifts in the coming months in both areas as contractors make gains on opening up four-lane sections.

Whenever you approach a work zone: slow down; allow extra distance between vehicles; read signs; obey road crew flaggers; and expect the unexpected.
