Rolling Lane Closures on the Downtown Connector will Affect Weekend and Weeknight Traffic

What:

Georgia Department of Transportation contractors will begin installing road pavement markers (RPMs) on I-75/I-85. The work will take place from University Avenue to the Brookwood Split. Crews will start installing the RPMs on I-75/I-85 southbound and will finish on I-75/I-85 northbound.

Weather permitting; the work will occur nightly from **9 p.m., until 5 a.m., starting on Sunday, January 31 until Saturday, February 6.**

Installing RPMs on the interstate is a slow moving operation therefore; Georgia DOT contractors will subsequently slow down traffic traveling on the Downtown Connector to complete their work. Motorists should expect multiple lane closures at a time and should slow down while driving through the work zone.

I-75/I-85 northbound and southbound from University Avenue to the Brookwood Split

Contractors and heavy equipment will be in the travel lanes. Motorists should significantly reduce their speeds while traveling through the work zone.
