CONTINUING TO PROVIDE A SAFE LEVEL OF COMFORT FOR USERS, GEORGIA DOT BEGINS TO REPAIR THE EDGES OF PAVEMENT ON THREE HIGHWAYS IN CARROLL, GORDON AND MURRAY COUNTIES

WHAT: Georgia DOT's Maintenance crews are set to work this week on repairing the deteriorating edges of pavement on State Route (SR) 166 in Carroll County, SR 136 in Murray County and SR 156 in Gordon County. Work will proceed daily between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., weather permitting.

Edge repair is a maintenance activity that is intended to guard against pavement failure along the edges due to the action of traffic and the loss of edge support that occurs due to the presence of water, aggressive-growth vegetation, and wind from either traffic or the atmosphere. Georgia DOT's edge repairs are designed to minimize the effects of shoulder drop offs and maximize the safety of the roadway for the traveling public.

WHEN: Tuesday, August 25 through Friday, August 28, 2015 from 7:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.

WHERE: SR 166 in Carroll County, SR 136 in Murray County and SR 156 in Gordon County
