### **Expect Delays: SR 21 & I-95 DDI Construction Continues**

**WHAT:** Contractors for Georgia DOT have been and will continue to resurface SR 21 at the I-95 interchange to reconstruct the existing interchange to a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI). Northbound lane closures on SR 21 and the I-95 northbound off-ramp will continue around the clock until 3 p.m., Friday, October 28, with the exception of a four-hour period between 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. each day. Motorists should expect major delays at this location and are advised to use alternate route, if possible.

This is a WORK ZONE and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this and all work zones. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.
