## **Nighttime Resurfacing Scheduled **Sunday** on F.J. Torras Causeway**

**WHAT:** Georgia DOT crews have scheduled temporary lane closures **Sunday** night to resurfacing a section on S.R. 25 Spur east/ F.J. Torras Causeway in Glynn County. Crews will remove rough pavement on the Torras Causeway between mile markers 1 and 2 then replace it with a smoother driving surface. In an effort to minimize the impact to the traveling public, the work will be accomplished at night.

This is a WORK ZONE and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this maintenance work zone. Directional signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

**WHEN:** **7 p.m., Sunday, June 21 until 7 a.m., Monday, June 22, weather permitting.**

**WHERE:** S.R. 25 Spur east/ F.J. Torras Causeway between mile markers 1 and 2 in Glynn County.
