## **GEORGIA DOT ANNOUNCES TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RIGHT TURN LANE ON TO F.J. TORRAS CAUSEWAY**

**WHEN:** Weekdays, 8 a.m. until 5 p.m., Tuesday, June 19 and continuing through, Friday, June 29, weather permitting.

**WHERE:** U.S. 17/S.R. 25 northbound, right turn lane for F.J. Torras Causeway in Glynn County.

**WHAT:** At the request of Georgia Power, Georgia DOT will temporarily close the right turn lane on U.S. 17/S.R. 25 that merges onto F.J. Torras Causeway in Brunswick. Work is scheduled weekdays between 9 a.m. until 5 p.m., starting Tuesday, June 19 and continuing through Friday, June 29, weather permitting. This temporary lane closure is utilized for replacement of Georgia Power's equipment in the marsh.

Motorist traveling northbound on U.S. 17/S.R.25 can access F.J. Torras Causeway at the intersection of U.S. 17/S.R.25 and F.J. Torras Causeway.

Motorist can expect daily lane closures and short delays. Please remember to slow down; be especially attentive and cautious as you pass through this and all construction work zones.

Motorists can access real-time, statewide, route-specific information on accidents, road work, traffic and weather conditions through **Georgia 511** - a free phone service. By dialing 511, callers also can transfer to operators 24 hours a day to report incidents or request assistance. The system can be used to access transit providers, major airports, rideshare organizations, tourism information and 511 systems in surrounding states. Additionally, 511 is available online. Georgia DOT partners with sponsors for assistance in funding 511, thereby preserving tax dollars and helping sustain critical services.
