## **F. J. Torras Causeway Gets Bridge Check-Up**

Single Lane Closures Scheduled

**WHAT:** Georgia DOT bridge crews have scheduled single lane closure today, Monday and Tuesday from 10 a.m. until 3 p.m. on F. J. Torras Causeway in Glynn County. Alternating directional lane closures are a necessity for specialized equipment to be utilized for routine bridge inspection on the Causeway. All work is weather contingent.

This is a **WORK ZONE** and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this work zone and expect minor delay in this area.

**WHEN:** 10 a.m. until 3 p.m., Wednesday, April 8, Monday, April 13 and Tuesday, April 14, weather permitting.

**WHERE:** S.R. 25 Spur East/F. J. Torras Causeway in Glynn County.
