### **GDOT Proposes a Diverging Diamond Interchange on Camp Creek over I-285**

**ATLANTA** – The Georgia Department of Transportation invites residents and commuters to give their input on the Georgia DOT’s plan to convert the state Route 6/Camp Creek interchange at I-285 to a diverging diamond interchange (DDI).

The informal open house will take place from **4 p.m., until 7 p.m., Wednesday, August 17 at the Aerotropolis Atlanta Community Improvement District office, 3800 Camp Creek Parkway, Building 1400, Suite 132, Atlanta, GA. 30331**

The proposed project would construct a diverging diamond interchange at the existing overpass on SR 6/Camp Creek Parkway at I-285. Construction would take place on the existing bridge and both shoulders will be reconstructed. Construction will also include improvements to SR 6/Camp Creek Parkway to accommodate the proposed interchange.

“The proposed DDI can improve the overall operational efficiency of the interchange for vehicular and truck traffic,” said Jeff Simmons, Georgia DOT project manager. “The proposed DDI is expected to add a \$7.7 million investment to the South Fulton community.”

Georgia DOT staff and engineers will be on hand to answer questions about the project. Residents who cannot attend the open house on August 17 can submit a written statement. All written statements should be submitted by **Monday, August 29** to:
