Guardrail Repairs Scheduled Tonight in Monroe, Dooly and Butts Counties

What: Contractors for Georgia DOT have schedule guardrail repairs tonight along Interstate 75 Monroe, Dooly and Butts counties. Weather permitting; work will be performed tonight, Monday, September 6 beginning at 8 p.m.

Crews will be working in half mile to 1 mile increments and relocating frequently. Motorists should be alert to changing work patterns.

Where: **Monroe County** – I-75 southbound at mile marker 184, Near Exit 185, 8 p.m. – 10:30 p.m.

Dooly County – I-17 northbound, Exit 122 off-ramp, single lane closure, 11 p.m.- 1:30 a.m.

Butts County – I-75 southbound, Exit 201 off ramp, single lane closure, 2 a.m.-5 a.m.

When: 8 p.m. until 5 a.m., Monday, September 6, weather permitting.

Motorists should expect minor delays. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through these maintenance work zones. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes.
