### **Keeping it Safe for Motorists: Guardrail Repairs at Various Locations in Central Georgia**

**What:** A contractor for Georgia DOT has scheduled guardrail repairs along Interstate 75 in multiple counties in Central Georgia. Weather permitting; work will be performed beginning tonight, July 12 at 8 p.m.

Crews will be working in half mile to 1 mile increments and relocating frequently. Motorists should be alert to changing work patterns.

**I-75 Southbound:**

- **Bibb** County –at mile marker 172, Bass Road, 8 p.m. – 10 p.m.
- **Henry** County - at mile marker 211, near Exit 212; Locust Grove Road, 10 p.m. – 1 a.m.
- **Butts** County –between mile marker 205 and 201, SR 16 and SR 36, 1 a.m. – 5 a.m.

Motorists should expect minor delays. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through these maintenance work zones. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes.
