## **Guardrail Repair Scheduled This Week in Bulloch, Camden and Chatham Counties**

**What:** A contractor for Georgia DOT have scheduled guardrail repairs for Thursday through Saturday between 8:30 a.m. until 4 p.m. in Bulloch, Chatham and Camden Counties. This work will require lane closures with possible flagging operations in some locations where the work will be performed.

Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this maintenance work zone. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

**When:** 8:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Thursday, February 4 through Saturday, February 6, weather permitting.

**Where & When:** **Bulloch County/Below Statesboro**

Left lane closure on I-16 westbound at mile marker 124.04 over Nevils Denmark Road on Thursday, February 4,

**Camden County/Kingsland**

Lane closure with flagging operation on SR 25 southbound at Georgia/Florida State Line on Friday, February 5.

**Chatham County/Savannah**

Narrow left travel lane on I-516 westbound at the beginning of Exit 2 to Veterans Parkway westbound on Saturday, February 6.
