CARROLLTON, Ga. - Georgia DOT Maintenance crews begin today their work on repairing the guardrail along State Route (SR) 166 and SR 5 in Carroll County and SR 6 in Paulding County. Work will proceed daily Tuesday through Friday between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., weather permitting.
