Keeping it Safe for Motorists: Guardrail Repairs at Various Locations in Middle Georgia

What: A contractor for Georgia DOT has schedule guardrail repairs along various interstates in multiple counties across West Central Georgia. Weather permitting; work will be performed nightly, beginning tonight, June 20 at 8 p.m.

Crews will be working in half mile to 1 mile increments and relocating frequently. Motorists should be alert to changing work patterns.

And When:

Monday, June 20:

Bibb County – I-75 *southbound* near mile marker 164, 8 p.m. – 11 p.m.

I-475 *northbound* near mile marker 1, 11 p.m. – 2 a.m.

Monroe County - I-475 *northbound* near mile marker 12, 2 a.m. – 5 a.m.

Tuesday, June 21:

Twiggs County – I-16 *eastbound* near mile marker 15, 8 p.m. – 9 p.m.

I-16 *westbound* near mile marker 29, 9 p.m. – midnight

I-16 *westbound* near mile marker 11, midnight – 3 a.m.

Motorists should expect minor delays. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through these maintenance work zones. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes.
