Work Continues as Single Lane Closures are Scheduled on I-16 East and Westbound Near the SR 96 Exit

WHAT: Daily lane closures continue this week as contractors for the Georgia Department of Transportation continue to construction on the SR 96 bridge over I-16. A single lane closure will be in place from 7 a.m. until 6 p.m. daily Tuesday, January 19 through Friday, January 22 in order for the contractor to safely work on the bridge and unload materials.

This is a WORK ZONE and extreme caution is necessary. Motorists are advised to reduce speeds as they travel through this and all work zones. Message signs, barrels and/or cones will be utilized to alert the public of the upcoming changes. Drivers should be aware that personnel and equipment will be operating in close proximity to travel lanes.

WHEN: Daily, Tuesday, January 19 through Friday, January 22, weather permitting

WHERE: I-16 east and westbound between mile marker 24 and 25, near Exit 24; SR 96
