RIGHT LANE OF I-20 EAST IN CARROLL COUNTY CLOSED TOMORROW FOR CONCRETE REPAIR

WHEN: Friday, April 20, 2012 from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.

WHERE: Interstate 20 eastbound between mile markers 23.5 and 24 in Carroll County

WHAT Motorists should expect the closure of the right lane of I-20 eastbound between Exit 19/State Route (SR) 113/Temple-Carrollton Road and Exit 24/SR 61/Industrial Boulevard in Carroll County. This lane closure is necessary for Georgia DOT Maintenance crews to repair the deteriorating concrete spots on this stretch of the Interstate. This maintenance operation and the lane closure it necessitates are weather permitting and subject to change.

Georgia DOT urges travelers to call 511 for updated information about this maintenance operation or any other construction project on interstates and state routes. Georgia 511 is a free phone service that provides real-time traffic and travel information statewide, such as traffic conditions, incidents, lane closures, and delays due to inclement weather.
