SINGLE LANE CLOSURE ON I-20 WESTBOUND FOR SLAB REPLACEMENT

WHEN: Tuesday, January 10, continuing through Thursday, January 12, weather permitting

WHERE: Westbound Interstate 20 between mile markers 201 and 200 in Richmond County

WHAT: The Georgia Department of Transportation has scheduled a single lane closure on I-20 westbound in order for crews to perform concrete slab replacement.

Motorists are advised to expect delays in this area and are asked to please help us prevent accidents in highway work zones by slowing down and being especially attentive and cautious as you travel in this and all highway work zones.

Georgia DOT urges travelers to call 511 for updated information about this or any other construction project on interstates and state routes. Georgia 511 is a free phone service that provides real-time traffic and travel information statewide, such as traffic conditions, incidents, lane closures, and delays due to inclement weather.
