TREE LIMBS CAUSING INTERFERENCE WITH CAMERAS

Lane Closure on I-75 Northbound Needed for a Trimming

WHEN: 9 a.m. until 2 p.m., Wednesday, September 5, weather permitting

WHERE: I-75 northbound at between mile markers 224 and 225 (Exit 224, Hudson Bridge Road/Eagles Landing Parkway)

WHAT: Georgia DOT Maintenance crews have scheduled a lane closure on I-75 northbound near Hudson Bridge Road in order to trim tree limbs that have grown too tall causing obstructions with nearby GDOT NaviGator cameras.

NaviGators video detection system (VDS) cameras are the primary source of real-time information about current travel conditions. Approximately 1,645 VDS stations are installed every 1/3 mile on most major interstates around Atlanta. These VDS cameras provide continuous speed and volume data and allow GDOT to confirm incident details, dispatch HERO units and request appropriate emergency personnel.
