Rolling Lane Closures on I-75 will Affect Weeknight and Weekend Traffic

What:

Georgia Department of Transportation contractors will begin installing road pavement markers (RPMs) on I-75 northbound. The work will take place between the I-675 interchange and Cumberland Boulevard.



Weather permitting; the work will occur nightly from **9 p.m., until 5 a.m., starting on Tuesday, February 16 until Sunday, February 21**

Installing RPMs on the interstate is a slow moving operation therefore; Georgia DOT contractors will subsequently slow down traffic traveling on I-75 to complete their work. Motorists should expect multiple lane closures at a time and slow down while driving through the work zone.

9 p.m., Tuesday, February 16 until 5 a.m., Wednesday, February 17
9 p.m., Wednesday, February 17 until 5 a.m., Thursday, February 18
9 p.m., Thursday, February 18 until 5 a.m., Friday, February 19
9 p.m., Friday, February 19 until 5 a.m., Saturday, February 20
9 p.m., Saturday, February 20 until 5 a.m., Sunday, February 21

Where:

I-75 northbound between the I-675 interchange and Cumberland Boulevard.

Advisory:

Contractors and heavy equipment will be in the travel lanes. Motorists should significantly reduce their speeds while traveling through the work zone.
