INTERSTATE 85 ASPHALT REPAIR TOMORROW

DULUTH, GA – The Georgia Department of Transportation will close the two outside lanes of Interstate 85 northbound tomorrow, April 21 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for asphalt repairs north of Old Peachtree Road, Exit 109.

A large pothole developed and the temporary patch is in place now. Crews will remove the damaged asphalt and replace it with new asphalt tomorrow. Delays are expected in the area as work occurs. Crews will complete the repairs as quickly as possible.
